

# LAMA Passenger Eligibility Form

 11<sup>th</sup> May 2022

When LAMA was formed in 1987, the aims of the association were defined as:

- To assist the work of organisations and bodies engaged in the:
  - Relief of poverty, sickness and the disabilities of age.
  - The provision of facilities for recreation or other leisure time occupation within the meaning of section 1 of the Recreational Charities Act 1958.
  - Any other charitable purpose in the area of Lerryn, St Veep, St Winnow and District.
- When necessary, to relieve poverty, sickness and the disabilities of age.

Under the terms of our Section 19 Permit, LAMA is authorised to carry only the following classes of passenger:

- Class A - members of the body holding the permit.
- Class B - persons whom the body exists to benefit, and persons assisting them.
- Class C - disabled persons (as defined in the Disability Discrimination Act 1995) or persons who are seriously ill and persons assisting them.
- Class D - pupils or students of any school, college, university or other educational establishment and staff or other helpers accompanying them.

## Eligibility Criteria

In order to be a passenger on any of the trips arranged by LAMA minibus, you must certify that you fulfil any one of the following eligibility criteria:

- I am aged 60 years or more.
- I am financially constrained (eg, claiming social welfare benefits, on low income, unemployed).
- I am disabled or suffer from long-term sickness (either physically or mentally).
- I am a student in full-time education.

I confirm that (tick appropriate box):

- I live in the area of Lerryn, St Veep, St Winnow and District (which includes Boconnoc and Lostwithiel) and I meet at least one of the eligibility criteria listed above.
- I am an assistant or helper to someone who is able to tick the box above, or I am temporarily in their care, and as such I understand that I am only entitled to travel on LAMA trips when accompanying that person.
